- Analysing sales and market data to adjust parameters in the forecasting tool, optimising replenishment orders, reducing waste and minimising supply chain disruptions.
- Ensuring 'right first time' creation and execution of product launches, maintaining the highest standards of accuracy.
- Applying replenishment cycle plans and calendars, ensuring processes are followed for smooth product flow through the supply chain.
- Identifying gaps in new processes and protocols, contributing improvement ideas and collaborating with stakeholders and supply chain partners for continuous process refinement.
- Contributing to decision-making with data-driven insights, supporting sales projections, commercial impacts, 'what if' analysis and change impact assessments.
- Striking the optimal balance between working capital and availability KPIs, ensuring stock levels are managed effectively to meet customer demand.
- Escalating alerts and warnings that require complex resolution or action, ensuring timely intervention to resolve any critical issues.
- Maintaining and updating knowledge on forecasting and replenishment methodologies and systems, ensuring continued alignment with industry best practices.
- Executing disaster recovery protocols during system outages, including the manual creation of supplier orders to ensure minimal disruption to stock flow.
- Collaborating with external and internal teams to resolve issues swiftly, ensuring replenishment orders are processed on time and without error.
- Ensuring stock levels are optimised throughout the replenishment cycle, aligning with demand forecasts and operational needs.
