Your duties and responsibilities:

- Working collaboratively with the warehouse and wider pharmacy team to ensure that operational targets are met daily, contributing to the smooth and efficient flow of stock, timely order fulfilment, and high standards of service across all areas.
- Accurately picking and preparing pharmacy orders for distribution, handling stock with care and precision, reporting any discrepancies, and ensuring items are safely stacked and documented in line with procedures.
- Receiving and processing incoming deliveries by checking goods against delivery notes, reporting any variances or damages, and ensuring all stock is safely stored in the correct bin locations with appropriate rotation based on expiry dates.
- Assisting with assembling patient prescriptions within the Central Fill automation area, adhering to all Standard Operating Procedures and pharmacy guidelines to ensure compliance and patient safety.
- Maintaining a clean, safe, and organised working environment throughout the warehouse by following health and safety procedures, wearing appropriate PPE, and promptly reporting any hazards or risks to the relevant team members.
- Supporting with additional tasks such as preparing and sending point-of-sale materials, store displays, and marketing collateral, as well as checking and storing returned or transferred stock in designated areas.
- Contributing to ongoing inventory control by carrying out regular stock counts, monitoring expiry dates, and processing returns or disposals of stock in accordance with MHRA regulations and company policies.
- Taking ownership of personal appearance, hygiene, and conduct, while also staying informed of operational updates, completing required training via the iLearn platform, and supporting colleagues by sharing best practices when needed.
- Undertaking Pharmacy Driver duties as and when needed - please refer to the relevant job description for a detailed list of responsibilities.
